

PUBLIC HOUSING

Fall River Housing Authority is the place to go for various types of housing, but most importantly, **it is the place to go for both state and federally-funded public housing**. By accessing the FRHA website you can apply for a Section 8 Housing Choice voucher and check on your public housing applications. The website is not only useful for those who are looking to access housing but is also a great resource for landlords who are looking to gain valuable information on renting to tenants with Section 8.

Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher

Section 8 is a program that subsidizes the rent of low-income families, elderly, and disabled individuals and allows them to find their own housing, including single-family homes, townhouses, and apartments. Under the Section 8 Housing Choice Program, a tenant may select a unit that rents for the amount determined to be comparable to other unassisted units in the area which would result in the family paying no more than 40% of its adjusted monthly income towards rent and utilities.

Family Self-Sufficiency Program

The Family Self-Sufficiency Program (FSS) is a HUD Program that works with individuals and their families on the Section 8 Program or those residents living in Federal Public Housing Units. The FSS Program is designed to assist participants in developing strategies to increase their financial stability and move forward on a path toward economic stability.

FIRST TIME HOME BUYERS

What is it?

A 3-day workshop on Zoom or a 2-night in-person class Held every other month alternating between Zoom and in-person

Who is it for?

- Anyone looking for education on buying a house for the first time
- Someone who is going to get a loan for a first-time home
- Anyone applying for first-time housing grants

How much does it cost?

\$50 per couple \$40 per/person

What do you get from the workshops?

2-3 Educational classes and receive a certificate upon completion that will be good for 2 years and good for all of Massachusetts and allow you to apply for housing grant opportunities

HOME PROGRAM

Community Development Agency has a First Time Homebuyer HOME Program

What is it?

Financial assistance for a downpayment or closing costs for a first-time home with a 1% interest rate for all HOME program loans.

Who is it for?

A first-time home buyer who is:

- Income eligible (please see next page)
- Creditworthy
- Does not owe outstanding property taxes
- Must have completed first-time homebuyers course
- Will be occupying the property for at least 5 years
- Property must be a 1-4 family property

EVICTION FACT SHEET

If you receive a Notice to Quit it does **NOT** mean you need to immediately leave your unit. What you should **DO** is:

- Begin looking for new housing **Do NOT wait until you are served a summons!**
- Decide if you want to proceed with legal action to defend yourself in the eviction and file your **Written Response** or **Answer Sheet**
- Reach out to the Housing Court Housing Specialist Department to learn about mediation for eviction once you receive a summons

Seniors are protected by a Massachusetts statute that can give them more time before they must leave their unit

Interested in defending your case?

- You have the right to raise defenses to the eviction such as:
 - Landlord did not fix the known conditions of the property
 - Eviction is retaliation for lawful activities
 - Discrimination
 - Landlord did not properly serve summons
 - Complaint doesn't state the reason for the eviction
- File the form that came with your Notice to Quit called the Answer Sheet within the proper timeframe given to you
- Gather all of the information and evidence you might need for your case
 - pictures of the apartment, any messages exchanged with the landlord regarding any issues that led to eviction, paperwork (ie lease, proof of rent payment, etc)
